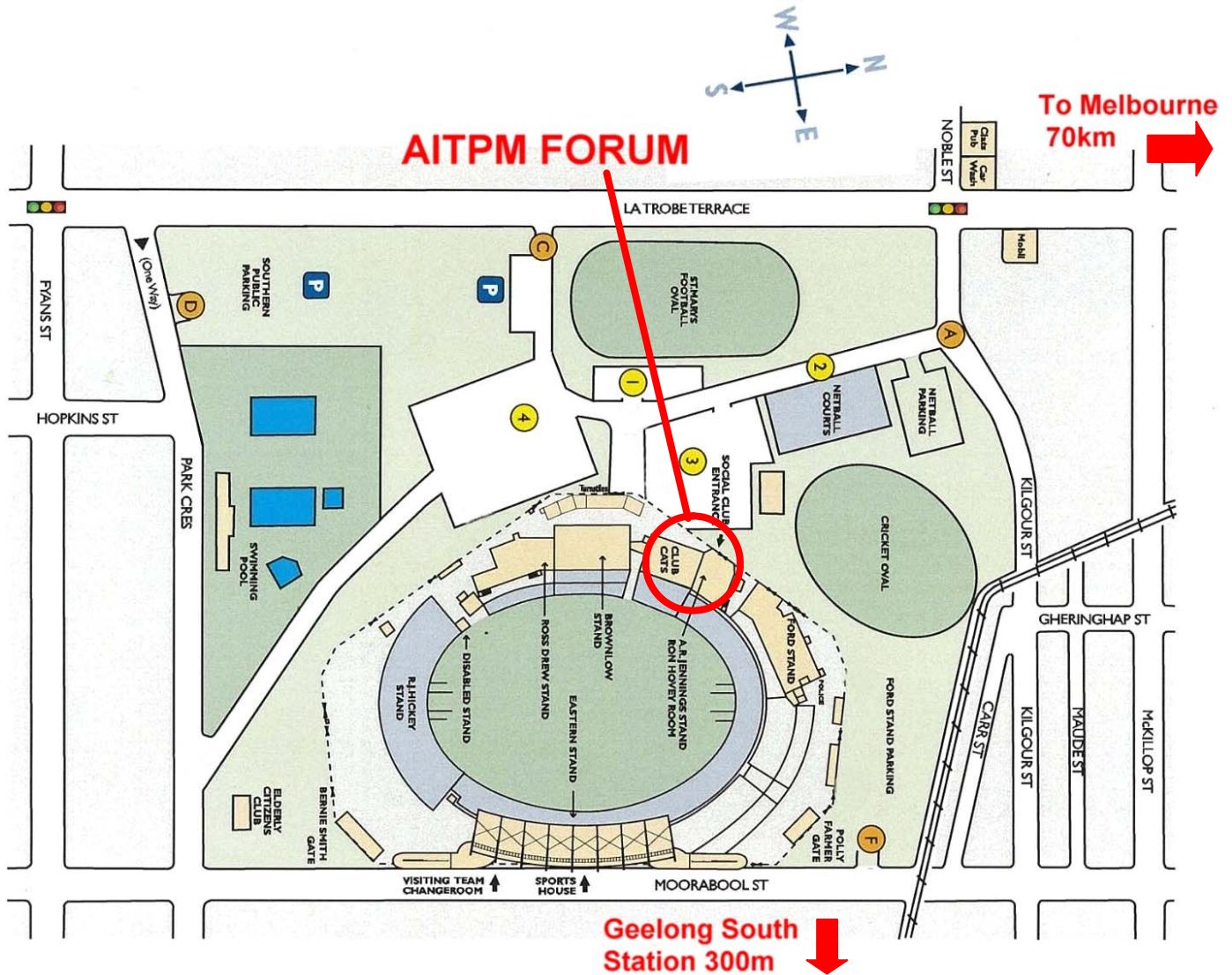

**Kardinia Park is also readily accessible by train from Melbourne (\$17.60 return):**

***Train to Geelong South Station (note do NOT get off at Geelong Station)***

departs Southern Cross Station at 12:00 noon,

arrives Geelong South station (a 300m walk from Kardinia Park) at 1:00pm

***Return trains***

depart Geelong South station at 4:56pm / 5:25pm / 6:24pm,

arrive Southern Cross station at 6:01pm / 6:43pm / 7:34pm
