# Planning for Sustainable Transport



Sydney's urban transport infrastructure is facing increasing pressure from population growth, whilst dealing with the legacy of existing congestion. The transport sector will face increasing demands to reduce its impact on climate change and assist in meeting reduced environmental impact targets.

State and local Governments, together with the private sector, need to plan for a sustainable transport system to keep pace with changing priorities. AITPM NSW Branch is pleased to present two speakers who can provide an insight into future planning principles for transport.

#### Dr Garry Glazebrook

Senior Lecturer, School of the Built Environment  
University of Technology Sydney

Dr Glazebrook will provide a presentation on planning a sustainable transport system for Sydney. He will outline how sustainability principles were included in the recently released Independent Public Inquiry into public transport for Sydney.

Dr Glazebrook has over 15 years' policy experience at both State and Federal government levels and 14 years' consulting experience, focusing on urban transport and planning. He currently teaches in urban planning at the University of Technology, Sydney. Dr Glazebrook has published widely in the fields of urban transport, including a 30 year Public Transport Plan for Sydney in 2009. He is a member of the Planning Institute of Australia, the International Union of Public Transport and the Association for the Study of Peak Oil, and was a member of the Steering Committee of the University of Sydney's Warren Centre Study of Sustainable Transport for Sydney. Dr Glazebrook has been an advisor to the Independent Public Inquiry into Public Transport for Sydney.

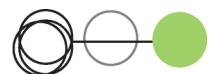

Bicycles can also be taken on board the Metro Light Rail at no extra cost.

Accessible parking spaces are available outside the Citizen Service Centre and in the Forum car park.

Discounted multi-ride tickets (TravelTen, TravelPasses and Rail Weeklies) are economical and convenient. Use a Blue TravelTen for short trips (eg. Annandale to Leichhardt) or a Brown TravelTen for longer trips (eg. City to Leichhardt), available at most news-agencies.
