Micro Analysis and Innovative Crash Reduction Solutions

The Blackspot Program has been in place for over 20 years and has been high successful in reducing road trauma. However, the quick wins or easy to treat intersections are becoming more difficult to find and some traditional measures are proving to be less effective. Over the past year Main Roads has been trialing an innovative approach to support the Towards Zero Road Safety Strategy. This approach takes a micro analysis investigation of each site followed by a group assessment of options via a variety of professions, including a behavioural expert. This presentation will provide an overview of the process, a look at a number of example intersections and the learning's to date.

Main Roads/IPWEA Process Improvement Group

Main Roads and Local Government manage a large metropolitan road network and share many common goals that ultimately support the community. To achieve our goals we need to work together to identify key issues and work up solutions. This is particularly relevant in an era of tight funding and limited experienced resources.
