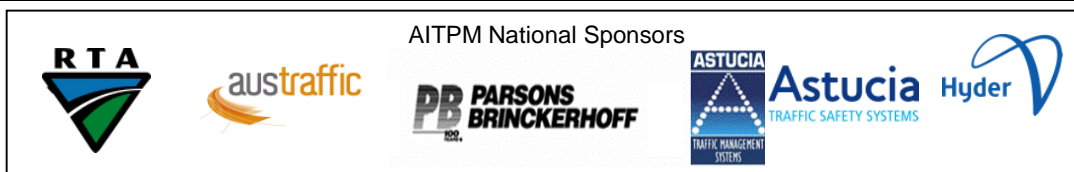

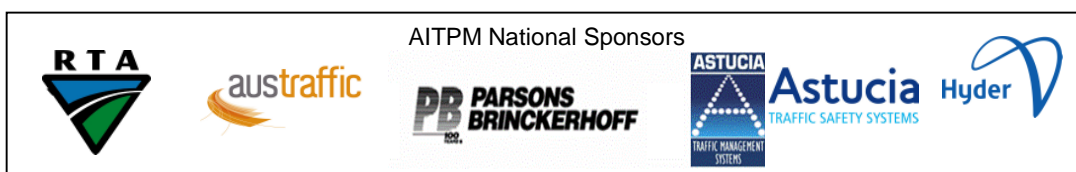
Tiiu Stojanovic - *Coordinator Traffic and Road Safety, City of Melville, Case Study dealing with an existing school*

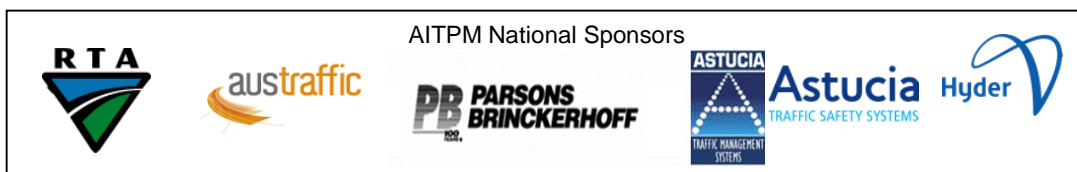
