Motorcycles – What is Happening on the Safety Front?

**Thursday 18th February 2010 – Main Roads
WA (Waterloo Crescent, East Perth)**

In recent years there has been a spike in the number of crashes involving motor cycles and a corresponding increase in the number crashes involving serious injuries and fatalities.

While most of us have experience driving a car, very few of us have ridden a motor cycle. This lack of practical experience and understanding has limited our ability to address the issues.

This Technical Forum has been arranged to provide a motor cyclists perspective, a rundown of the key crash types/causes and an overview of new safety initiatives.

David Wright -David is a President of the WA Branch of the Motor Cyclist Association and will provide the motor cyclists perspective.
